What is ISPRS?

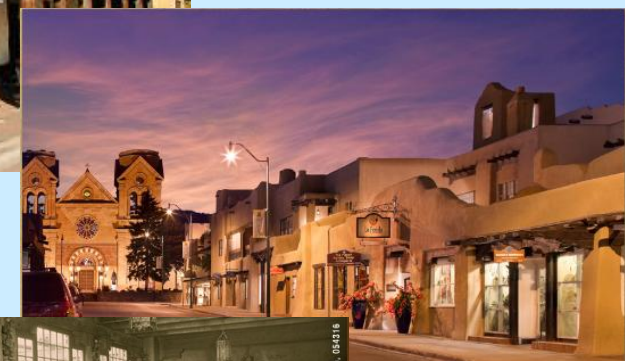
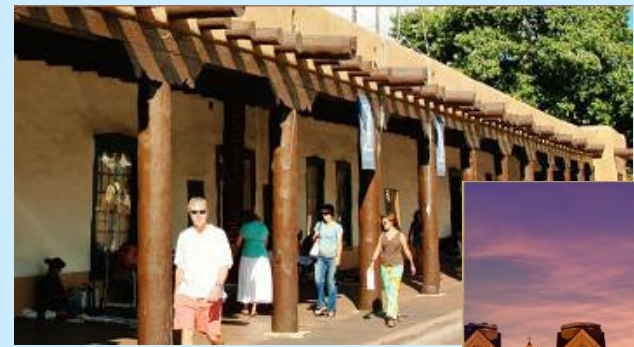
- International professional society that focuses on geospatial technologies

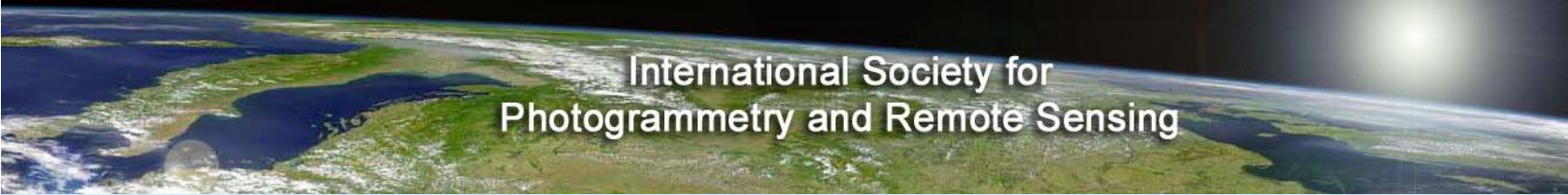
The Workshop in 2011....
